### **Bryston BDP1 Digital Player**

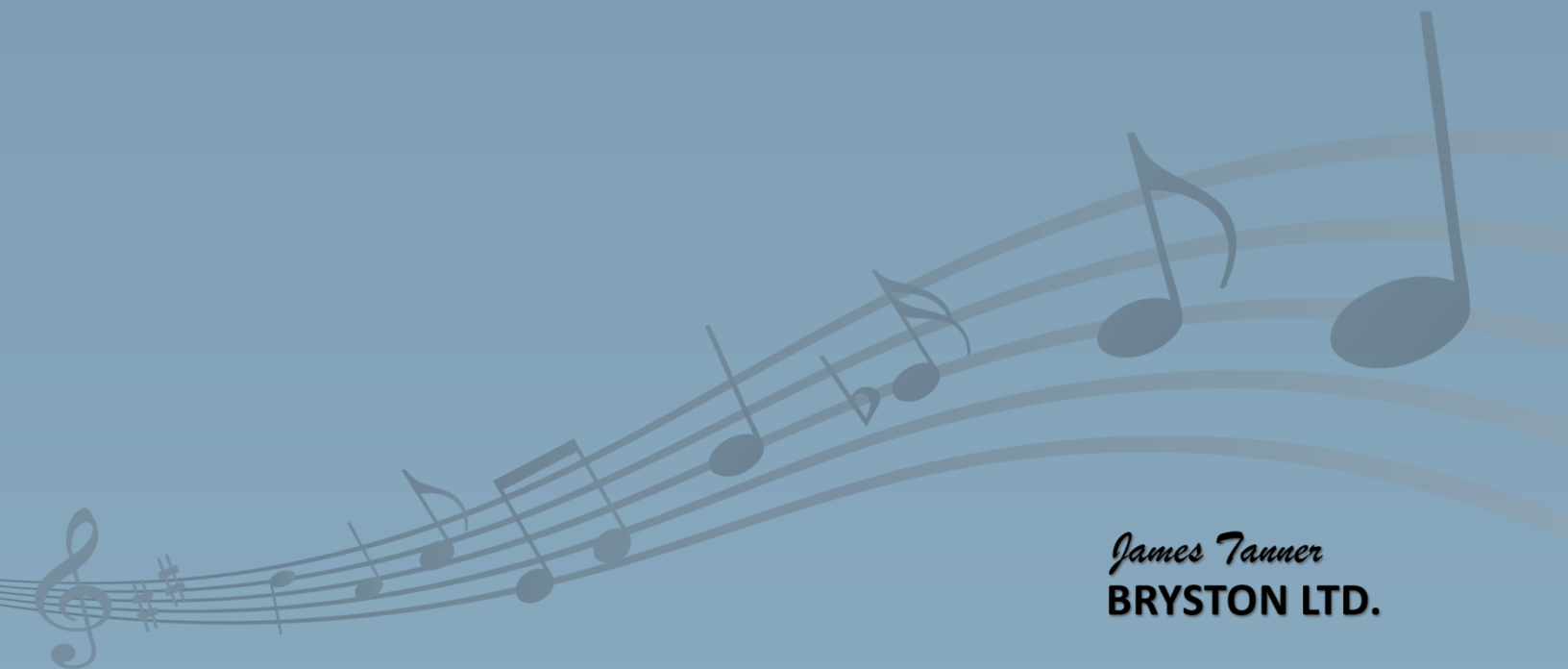
The astonishing new BDP1 Digital Player is a technological tour de force that bridges generational divides: between the old world CD player and the new world of high-resolution files and music-library management.



The BDP1 performs the same function as a CD transport, but plays data files from removable USB storage media at their native resolution and in a multiplicity of file formats. As we dedicated CD transports, the BDP1 offers only digital output, in both S/PDIF and AES/EBU formats, for connection to an external DAC. The Bryston BDP1 doesn't merely "sound better," the experience of hearing music through it is qualitatively different. It plays music with unprecedented purity.

This remarkable device single-handedly creates an entirely new product-category-one that bridges the generational divide between the old world familiarity of a CD player and the new world of high resolution files and music-library management, between a past constrained by frustratingly compromised digital audio sound quality and an exciting future in which digital artefacts have finally been reduced to inconsequential levels. The BDP1 plays files from removable USB storage media, at any sampling frequency and bit-depth to 192kHz/24-bit. Its digital output feeds your outboard DAC. In addition to its state-of-the-art sound quality, what makes the BDP1 so special is its functionality. Not only does it mimic CD transport controls; it also can connect to a home network, receive Internet Radio, and be controlled by a tablet or other hand-held device. The BDP1 offers a level of detail, clarity, focus, dynamics, and resolution that is nothing short of revelatory.
